

From Noah to Babel ~500 yrs


From Babel to Abram ~500 yrs

• 2000-1000 BC ABRAHAM, ISAAC, & JACOB


• 2000-1200 BC THE BRONZE AGE, MOSES








Ore – Required Melting






BELLOWS & OXYGEN





SMELTER DIAGRAM

The process of turning preheated rock/ore into molten cast iron.

- 1. Gases released
- 2. FeO is an iron oxide
- 3. Carbon monoxide or dioxide are released
- 4. CaCO₃ limestone
- 5. SiO₂ quartz
- 6. CO₂ gas released
- 7. Preheated blasts of air are added (bellows).
- 8. Slag CaSiO₃
- 9. Molten Iron

REMEMBER THESE THINGS

Deuteronomy 8:7-9 For the Lord your God is bringing you into a good land, a land of brooks of water, of fountains and springs, that flow out of valleys and hills; a land of wheat and barley, of vines and fig trees and pomegranates, a land of olive oil and honey; a land in which you will eat bread without scarcity, in which you will lack nothing; **a land whose stones are iron and out of whose hills you can dig copper.**
